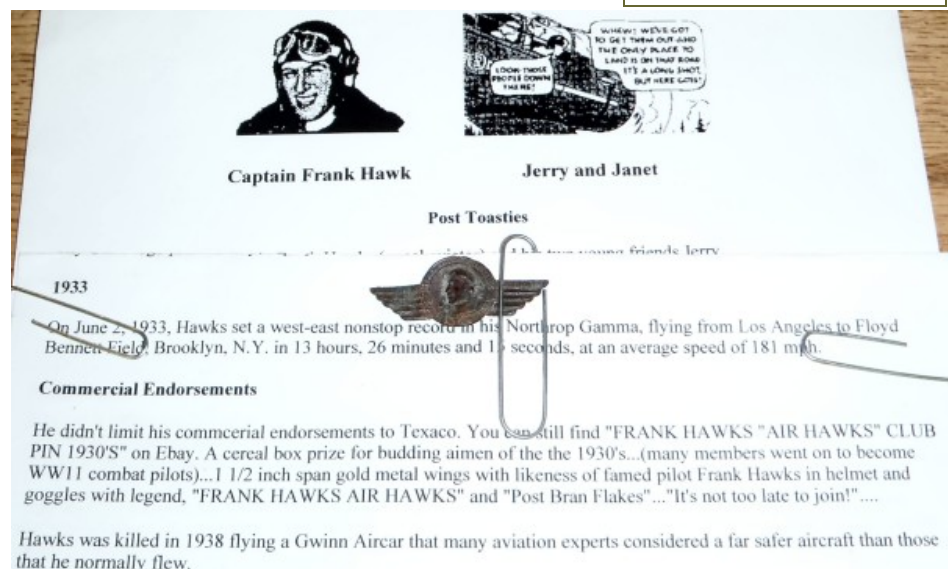

February Raffle

Congratulations to everyone who participated and won one of the uncirculated coins from last month. There were two uncirculated dollar coins, half dollar coins, quarters and dimes, all silver.

This month's raffle features quite an eclectic collection of coins and paper money. This is the first time we have had paper money in the raffle. It is a 1957 Silver Certificate. It states on the front of the bill that there is one dollar in silver on deposit in the treasury of the United States. It goes on to state "One Dollar in silver payable to the bearer on demand." Of course that is no longer true. 1964 was the last date you could trade your silver certificate for a silver dollar coin and 1968 was the last date you could trade for silver bullion but it is an interesting piece of American history and is still worth a dollar at your local bank. Other coins in the raffle include a graded 1946-S MS66 dime appraised at \$35, a commemorative 1971 Eisenhower silver proof, a 1906 Barber quarter, 1936 & 1940 silver quarters, an 1865 3 cent nickel, 2 uncirculated key date pennies - 1932D & 1943 Steel, and 6 Indian Head Pennies with some toning, and finally 2 Kennedy halves that are 40% silver.
