Raffle Items

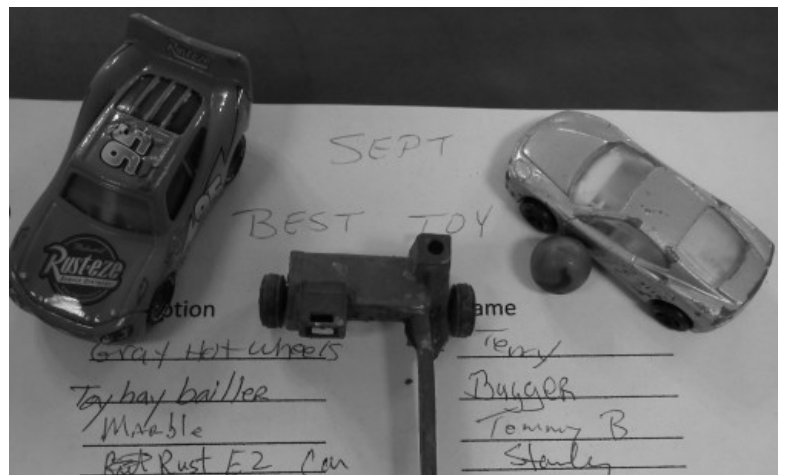
Since silver went on sale this week, the raffle will be an all silver affair again. The picture to the right shows all the items in the October club meeting raffle.
